6,000 VOLUNTEERS CAME TO HELP.

THANKSGIVING DAY: 6,000 volunteers came to deliver food on Thanksgiving day. The turkeys, Thanksgiving baskets, and hot meals went to 6,000 families, representing **25,017** people, the most ever.

MEDICAL CLINIC



- The clinic had **8,926** patient visits in 2015.
- The clinic provided **\$1,199,695** of free health care,
- and **\$1,591,870** worth of free medications.

THE CHRISTMAS STORE



The Christmas Store, filled with volunteers and parents shopping for their children.

- More than **thirty thousand** children (30,514) received free gifts from the Christmas Store.
- **4,000** bikes were delivered.
