They led Rainbow Express in **86 locations** in Arlington, Grand Prairie, and in other locations around the DFW Metroplex.

An average of **1,900 children** attended each day. **200 children** accepted Christ.

Allan Saxe Dental Clinic

The clinic was open for one hundred and seventy-two (172) days in 2003. 1,456 patients were seen for a total of 4,603 times. Seven hundred and eighty-eight (788) patients were first time patients. Volunteers contributed more than 3,484 hours of service.

The Saxe Dental Clinic saw a twenty-two (22) percent increase in total care provided over 2002, while still being forced to turn away more patients than it was able to accept.

Dr. Bob Mann Medical Clinic

Twenty-two medical doctors, fifty nurses, five physician assistants, and multiple other clerical volunteers are working together to treat more than four hundred and fifty (450) patients each month.
