Dr. Chili Robinson (pictured left) is a plastic surgeon who serves at our **FREE MEDICAL CLINIC** on Tuesdays. Early in June, a man came to the clinic with a **large mass** (a keloid) dangling from his left ear. The mass was the size of a small orange. Dr. Robinson saw him sign in, took him in immediately, and removed the mass. The patient was so thankful, he was in tears. We are grateful for all of the medical volunteers like Dr. Robinson who take care of people here five days each week. The Medical Clinic treated **977 PATIENTS** this month.
