

### November 27th <sup>m</sup> The Promise Candle

Light the Candle Read: Luke 1:75b-79

**Speaker:** In the New International Version of the Bible, the word "light" appears 204 times. The first appearance is in the first chapter of Genesis, the last is in the last chapter of Revelation. The notion of light runs throughout Scripture.

Maybe you feel like you have been stumbling around in the dark for a long time. John the Baptist came to tell us about God's kindness and the peace that comes through following His Son.

# **December 4th ¤ The Mary Candle**

**Light the Candle** (have the Promise Candle already lit)

**Read:** Luke 1:35-38

**Speaker:** Light came into the world through the availability of a young girl. Are you available to God? He wants to work through you as well.

## December 11th # The Joseph Candle

**Light the Candle** (have the Promise and Mary Candles already lit)

**Read:** Matthew 1:18-20, 24

**Speaker:** Times of doubting come to our lives. We sometimes wonder who and what we can trust. Joseph found God trustworthy. Will you take a step of faith in order to discover what Joseph discovered?

#### **December 18th ¤ The Bethlehem Candle**

**Light the Candle** (have the Promise, Mary, and Joseph Candles already lit)

**Read:** Luke 2:1-3, Micah 5:2

**Speaker:** God was ready to send "the Light" into the world, but one more thing was necessary. God had promised that His Son would be born in a small, insignificant town. How will Joseph and Mary get there?

### December 25th <sup>m</sup> The Christ Candle

**Light the Candle** (have the Promise, Mary, Joseph, and Bethlehem Candles already lit)

**Read:** Luke 2:6-11

**Speaker:** Light has come into the world. Jesus has been born. This happens to be so much more than a sweet story, though. This story becomes all that it is supposed to be when YOU follow the example of those humble shepherds so long ago. They met the Savior and then they told everyone! Go and Tell!
