First Sunday of Advent • The PEACE Candle

Light the Candle

Reference: Luke 1:13-17

Speaker: God heard Zechariah's prayer. The Bible says, "The prayer of a godly person is powerful. It makes things happen." (James 5:16b NIV) Trusting in the God who answers prayers give us **PEACE** even when things are difficult. It allowed Zechariah to know that his own son would prepare the way for the coming of God's Son!

Second Sunday of Advent • The HOPE Candle

Light the Candle (have the Peace Candle already lit)

Reference: Luke 1:46-49

Speaker: The Hebrew people had waited and waited for the coming of God's Son. When Mary was told that God would send His Son through her, she believed and put her **HOPE** in God. Have you believed and put your hope in Him?

Third Sunday of Advent • The JOY Candle

Light the Candle (have the Peace and Hope Candles already lit)

Reference: Matthew 1:18-21, 24

Speaker: Obedience to the Lord brings **JOY**. When the angel explained Mary's situation to Joseph,

he immediately obeyed and married Mary.

Fourth Sunday of Advent • The LOVE Candle

Light the Candle (have the Peace, Hope, and Joy Candles already lit)

Reference: Romans 5:8 and John 3:16

Speaker: God **LOVES** you with an everlasting love. That is why He sent His Son.

Christmas Day • The CHRIST Candle

Light the Candle (have the Peace, Hope, Joy, and Love Candles already lit)

Reference: Philippians 2:5-8

Speaker: Jesus **CHRIST** didn't simply begin to exist the day the angel Gabriel announced the good news to Mary. He has always existed with God. Jesus was completely obedient when God sent Him to earth to be born in a human body. He was obedient even to His death on the cross. What great **LOVE!**
