Abel	Genesis 4:1-16	And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him. Hebrews 11:6
Enoch	Genesis 5:21-24	Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see. Hebrews 11:1
Abraham	Genesis 12:1-9; 22:1-18	For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. Jn 3:16
Elijah	1 Kings 18	Jesus answered, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. The only way to the Father is through me. John 14:6
Joshua	Joshua 1	Choose for yourselves right now whom you will serve. .. But as for me and my family, we will serve the Lord. Joshua 24:15
Cornelius	Acts 10:1-48	Listen to his voice today. If you hear it, don't be stubborn. Hebrews 3:7-8a
Rahab	Joshua 2, 6	What I'm about to tell you is true. Anyone who hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life. They will not be judged. They have crossed over from death to life. John 5:24
Mary Magdalene	John 20:1-18	Anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! 2 Corinthians 5:17
Stephen	Acts 6:1-8:4	You should know that your body is a temple for the Holy Spirit who is in you. You have received the Holy Spirit from God. So you do not belong to yourselves, because you were bought by God for a price. So honor God with your bodies. 1 Corinthians 6:19-20
Job	Job 1:1-2:10, 42:1-17	Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5-6
Gideon	Judges 6-8	I am the Lord All-Powerful. So don't depend on your own power or strength, but on my Spirit. Zechariah 4:6
Samson	Judges 13-16	If you are guided by the Spirit, you won't obey your selfish desires. Galatians 5:16 (CEV)

Samuel	1 Samuel 2:18-12:25	Never give up. Eagerly follow the Holy Spirit and serve the Lord. Romans 12:11
Joseph	Genesis 41:1-45:28	But those who wait upon God get fresh strength. They spread their wings and soar like eagles, they run and don't get tired, they walk and don't lag behind. Isaiah 40:31
Moses	Exodus 5:1-14:3, 20:1-26	Lord, show me your ways. Teach me how to follow you. Psalm 25:4
Daniel	Daniel 1, 6	Do not worry about anything, but pray and ask God for everything you need, always giving thanks. Philippians 4:6
Matthew	Matthew 9:9-13	Seek first God's kingdom and what God wants. Then all your other needs will be met as well. Matthew 6:33
Aquila and Priscilla	Acts 18:1-28	All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for showing people what is wrong in their lives, for correcting faults, and for teaching how to live right. Using the Scriptures, the person who serves God will be capable, having all that is needed to do every good work. 2 Timothy 3:16-17
Jesus	Luke 4:14-21	If you love me, you will obey my commands. John 14:15
Mordecai	Esther 1, 2	Anyone who knows the right thing to do, but does not do it, is sinning. James 4:17
Andrew	Jn 1:35-42; Mt 4:12-20; Jn 6:1-15	None of you should look out just for your own good. Each of you should also look out for the good of others. Philippians 2:4
Barnabas	Acts 4:32-37, 9:19-31, 11:19-30, 12:24-25, Acts 13-15	When you talk, do not say harmful things, but say what people need—words that will help others become stronger. Then what you say will do good to those who listen to you. Ephesians 4:29
Silas	Acts 15:22-16:40	I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me. Philippians 4:13
Paul	Acts 8:1-3, 9:1-30; 2 Timothy 4	I have fought the good fight. I have finished the race. I have kept the faith. 2 Timothy 4:7
Peter	John 21; Acts 2-4	God is the one who began this good work in you, and I am certain that he won't stop before it is complete on the day that Christ Jesus returns. Philippians 1:6
