PROMISE

Genesis 3:15	I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; He will crush your head and you will strike His heel.
Genesis 22:18	Through your offspring, [Abraham], all nations on earth will be blessed, because you have obeyed me.
Exodus 33:14	My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest.
Leviticus 26:12	I will walk among you and be your God, and you will be my people.
Numbers 14:18a	The LORD is slow to anger, abounding in love and forgiving sin and rebellion.
Deut 4:29	If . . . you seek the LORD your God, you will find him if you seek him with all your heart and with all your soul.
Joshua 1:8	Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.
Judges 2:1	The angel of the LORD . . . said, "I brought you up out of Egypt and led you into the land I swore to give to your ancestors. I said, 'I will never break my covenant with you.' "
Ruth 4:14	Praise be to the LORD, who this day has not left you without a guardian-redeemer.

Jeremiah 1:5a	Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart.
Jeremiah 7:23	Obey me, and I will be your God and you will be my people. Walk in obedience to all I command you, that it may go well with you.
Jeremiah 29:11	"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."
Jeremiah 33:3	Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.
Lam 3:21-23	Yet this I call to mind and therefore I have hope: Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.
Ezekiel 11:19	I will give them an undivided heart and put a new spirit in them; I will remove from them their heart of stone and give them a heart of flesh.
Daniel 2:21	[God] changes times and seasons; he removes kings and sets up kings; he gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding; (ESV)
Daniel 4:17	The decision is announced by messengers, the holy ones declare the verdict, so that the living may know that the Most High is sovereign over all kingdoms on earth and gives them to anyone he wishes and sets over them the lowliest of people.
Hosea 6:6	For I desire mercy, not sacrifice, and acknowledgment of God rather than burnt offerings.
Hosea 14:9b	The ways of the LORD are right; the righteous walk in them, but the rebellious stumble in them.

Jonah 2:9b	Salvation comes from the LORD.
Jonah 4:2b	You are a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger and abounding in love, a God who relents from sending calamity.
Micah 7:7	But as for me, I watch in hope for the LORD, I wait for God my Savior; my God will hear me.
Micah 7:18	Who is a God like you, who pardons sin and forgives the transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? You do not stay angry forever but delight to show mercy.
Nahum 1:3	The LORD is slow to anger but great in power; the LORD will not leave the guilty unpunished.
Nahum 1:7	The LORD is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in him.
Hab 2:4	But the righteous will live by his faith.
Hab 3:19	The LORD gives me strength. He makes my feet as sure as those of a deer, and he helps me stand on the mountains. (CEV)
Zeph 3:17	The LORD your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing.
Haggai 2:5	This is what I covenanted with you when you came out of Egypt. And my Spirit remains among you. Do not fear.
Zech 1:3	“Return to me,” declares the LORD Almighty, “and I will return to you,” says the LORD Almighty.”
Zech 14:9	The LORD will be king over the whole earth. On that day there will be one LORD, and his name the only name.
Malachi 3:6a	I the LORD do not change.
Matt 6:33	But put God’s kingdom first. Do what he wants you to do. Then all of those things will also be given to you.
Matt 11:28	Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.

John 10:9-10	I am the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved. They will come in and go out, and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.
John 11:25-26	Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?"
John 15:5	I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.
Acts 1:8	But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.
Acts 1:11	Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven."
Acts 4:12	Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.
Romans 8:18	I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.
Romans 8:28	And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
Romans 12:2	Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.
1 Cor 1:18	For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.
1 Cor 6:19-20	Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.
1 Cor 15:58	Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.
2 Cor 1:3-4	Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God.
2 Cor 5:17	Therefore, if anyone <i>is</i> in Christ, <i>he is</i> a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. (NKJV)
2 Cor 5:21	God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
2 Cor 9:7b	God loves a cheerful giver. (see 2 Corinthians 9:6-8)
Gal 2:20	I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

Gal 5:16	So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.
Gal 5:22-25	But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.
Eph 1:3	Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.
Eph 2:8	For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God.
Eph 2:10	For we are God’s handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
Eph 3:20	Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us.
Phil 1:6	Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
Phil 2:13	For it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.
Phil 4:6-7	Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
Phil 4:19	And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.
Colossians 1:13	For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves
Colossians 1:22	But now he has reconciled you by Christ’s physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation
1 Thess 4:16-17	For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.
1 Thess 5:9-10	For god did not appoint us to suffer wrath but to receive salvation through our Lord Jesus Christ. He died for us so that, whether we are awake or asleep, we may live together with Him.
2 Thess 3:5	I pray that the Lord will guide you to be as loving as God and as patient as Christ. (CEV)
1 Tim 1:15a	Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners. (see 1 Timothy 1:15-16)
1 Tim 2:5	There is only one God, and Christ Jesus is the only one who can bring us to God. Jesus was truly human, and he gave himself to rescue all of us. (CEV)
1 Tim 4:8	Physical training is good, but training for godliness is much better, promising benefits in this life and in the life to come. (NLT)
1 Tim 6:6	You gain a lot when you live a godly life. But you must be happy with what you have. (NIRV)
2 Tim 1:7	God’s Spirit doesn’t make cowards out of us. The Spirit gives us power, love, and self-control. (CEV)

2 Tim 2:11-13	Here is a true message: “If we died with Christ, we will live with him. If we don’t give up, we will rule with him. If we deny that we know him, he will deny that he knows us. If we are not faithful, he will still be faithful. Christ cannot deny who he is.”
2 Tim 3:16-17	All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
2 Tim 4:8	Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.
Titus 2:11	For the grace of God has appeared that offers salvation to all people.
Philemon 1:25	The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ <i>be</i> with your spirit.
Hebrews 2:18	Because he himself suffered when he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.
Hebrews 4:15	We have a high priest who can feel it when we are weak and hurting. We have a high priest who has been tempted in every way, just as we are. But he did not sin. (NirV)
Hebrews 4:16	So let us boldly approach the throne of grace. Then we will receive mercy. We will find grace to help us when we need it. (NirV)
Hebrews 11:1	Faith is being sure of what we hope for. It is being certain of what we do not see. (NirV)
Hebrews 11:6	And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.
Hebrews 13:8	Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.
James 1:3-4	The testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
James 1:17a	Every good and perfect gift is from God. It comes down from the Father.
James 4:7	Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
James 5:16b	The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.
James 5:20	Remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins.
1 Peter 1:3-4	Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade. This inheritance is kept in heaven for you.
1 Peter 1:18-19	For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your ancestors, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.
1 Peter 2:9	But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.
1 Peter 5:7	Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.

2 Peter 1:3	His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of him who called us by His own glory and goodness.
2 Peter 3:8-9	But do not forget this one thing, dear friends: With the Lord a day is like a thousand years, and a thousand years are like a day. The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.
2 Peter 3:13	But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to a new heaven and a new earth, where righteousness dwells.
1 John 1:5a	God is light; in him there is no darkness at all.
1 John 1:7	But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.
1 John 1:9	If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
1 John 2:17	The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever.
1 John 3:2	Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when Christ appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.
1 John 4:18	There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.
1 John 5:11-12	And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life; whoever does not have the Son of God does not have life.
1 John 5:14-15	This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him.
2 John 1:9	Anyone who runs ahead and does not continue in the teaching of Christ does not have God; whoever continues in the teaching has both the Father and the Son.
3 John 1:11	Dear friend, do not imitate what is evil but what is good. Anyone who does what is good is from God. Anyone who does what is evil has not seen God.
Jude 1:24 (NLV)	There is One Who can keep you from falling and can bring you before Himself free from all sin. He can give you great joy as you stand before Him in His shining-greatness.
Rev 1:3 (NLV)	The man who reads this Book and listens to it being read and obeys what it says will be happy. For all these things will happen soon.
Rev 1:18 (NLV)	I am the Living One. I was dead, but look, I am alive forever. I have power over death and hell.
Rev 3:20 (NLV)	See! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and we will eat together
Rev 5:9	And they sang a new song, saying: “[Jesus] You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you purchased for God persons from every tribe and language and people and nation.
Rev 11:15	The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said: “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Messiah, and He will reign for ever and ever.”
Rev 21:4 (NLV)	God will take away all their tears. There will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All the old things have passed away.
