How can I give a Monthly Donation?

1) You can send a MONTHLY CHECK to: 210 W. South, Arlington, TX 76010. We can give you pre-printed envelopes to assist you in mailing checks to us.

2) You can do a CREDIT CARD DONATION online at our website at:

On the Home Page, go to the bottom right hand side and click "On Line Donations." Follow instructions.

3) You can authorize us to automatically charge a monthly credit card dona-

tion for you on the 1st or 15th of every month. We will send you a receipt and thank you in the mail.

How can I give a Memorial or Honor gift?

◆ You can give using any of the methods listed above.

◆ Mark your donation "In Memory of" or "In Honor of" and give us the name. Note the name of the person or family to receive the acknowledgement.

We will mail that person or family a card letting them know we have received a donation in their name or in memory of their loved one.
